PREPARATION FOR MORNING COLONOSCOPY

It is important to drink plenty of clear fluids the day before your procedure to avoid DEHYDRATION and ELECTROLYTE IMBALANCE.

We recommend that you drink a combination of the following clear fluids:

- Gatorade (lemon or lime flavoured) or Staminade
- Fruit juices (apple, pear or grape)
- Plain jelly (lemon or pineapple flavours)
- Clear chicken broth or strained chicken noodle soup
- Black tea or coffee
- Lemon or lime cordial
- Water of any kind

THE DAY BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

8.00am	Do not eat any food after midnight. 2 glasses of approved clear fluids.	
10.00am	2 glasses of approved clear fluids.	
1.00 -2.00pm	Mix one sachet of Picoprep in a glass of water and drink. Drink another 2 glasses of approved clear fluids.	
3.00 – 4.00pm	Mix one sachet of Picoprep in a glass of water and drink. Drink another 2 glasses of approved clear fluids.	
5.00 – 6.00pm	Mix one sachet of Picoprep in a glass of water and drink. another 2 glasses of approved clear fluids .	Drink

Please ensure that there is a minimum of 2 hours between the doses of PICOPREP. Drink approximately 3 glasses of **approved clear fluids** until bedtime.

ON THE DAY OF YOUR COLONOSCOPY

6.00 – 7.00amTake your regular medications as usual with a sip of water.

Do not eat or drink prior to your procedure.

The bowel preparation will cause multiple bowel motions, usually within 2-3 hours of the first dose, but the response is variable. You may experience intermittent abdominal cramps. Remain within easy reach of the toilet after starting the preparation.

DO NOT HAVE ANY OTHER FOOD OR DRINK BEFORE THE COLONOSCOPY
